Summer Works/Buildings

The school will be applying for Additional Accommodations for a solid structure SET Room, Emergency Works to replace and fix the septic tank and soak away and Summer Works to replace the boiler and heating system.

Solar panels were installed on the roof at the back of the school on February 1st and we are already noticing a drop in our electricity bills.

Plumbing maintenance is ongoing in the school.

Staffing

No changes to staff for next year thankfully. SET hours will remain at 20 hours per week. We will continue to have 2 full time SNAs. There may be a change of personnel with regard to the Principal Release Day Teacher but that post is based in Castletownshend NS so they will be recruiting for that post. We also welcomed a student teacher, Miss Cronin to our school for 5 weeks.

School Initiatives

Our school garden is nearly complete. We have achieved our Active Flag, Our Green Flag and the Junior Entrepreneur Awards. We also had great success in the Maths Week Target Board Challenge.

Policy Development

The following policies were all reviewed this year by the BOM: Admissions, Anti-Bullying, Child Protection Safeguarding and Risk Assessment, Health and Safety, Substance Use, Whistleblowing/Protected Disclosures, Code of Behaviour

The Bí Cineálta, Working Together and Parental Complaints Procedures Policies were drafted and adopted.

School Inspection

No DES inspections took place in our school this year but we are up to date with our biannual inspections for servicing of our SET equipment.

Curricular Development

Work is ongoing for School Self Evaluation this year in the area of Drama and Oral Language. We have adopted many new initiatives to enrich the teaching and learning in these areas. Next year's focus will be ICT. 2nd-6th Class learned French for 10 weeks as part of the Say Yes to Languages Programme. The new primary curriculum will continue to be introduced next year which will mean some more training
